## This funding will be used to

- Support our explicit improvement agenda developed from feedback received in our Internal School Review (ISR) in 2015.
- In 2019, we will focus on two specific areas of student learning:
  - “Water Conservation” (our Sustainability focus)
  - Streamlining our process of “Student Induction” and the provision of a highly engaging presentation for delivery in a remote setting.
- Our “Capability Development” for 2019 will focus on these targeted areas.
- Data collection will measure improved student learning and engagement.

## Our initiatives include

- The development and production of:
  - A short video that will engage and instruct students in our “Water Conservation” focus area.
  - A Video/DVD that provides a highly visual and engaging student induction presentation, for the bus trip, prior to students arrival.
- These presentations will be available for use in two locations:
  - Onsite by visiting students, using our Centre iPads.
  - Offsite by teachers and students via our website, by DVD and during pre-visits.
- Practical application of this knowledge and skills in the context of camp programs.
- Teacher facilitated debriefing processes will further evaluate student learning.
- Teacher relief to allow for this work to be completed.

## Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Tinaroo Environmental Education Centre staff will develop and produce these presentations. The services of a professional will be engaged to assist the process. Each student who visits will have the opportunity to view these presentations, apply the knowledge and participate effectively. Students' experiences and understandings will be enhanced with our explicit approach to these focus areas.
