## Our initiatives include


- Upskilling of teachers to better engage students who attend educational programs at TEEC, through the use of trauma focused adventure therapy practices:
  - Two-day skills workshop for TEEC teachers facilitated by Youth Flourish Outdoors (YFO)
  - Focused review of our pedagogical framework to incorporate trauma focussed adventure therapy practices
  - Internal skill development days to practice the skills and process involved in implementing a trauma focussed approach
- Teacher facilitated review processes will further evaluate student engagement and active participation
- Teacher relief to allow this work to be completed

## Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Through the YFO workshop and review of our pedagogical framework, TEEC teachers will develop and implement practices that increase the participation and active engagement of students who would otherwise be disengaged and reluctant participants
- New practices will be shared through observation and discussion with visiting teachers and parents on camps at TEEC.
