Each school review generates a number of key improvement strategies to inform continuous improvement in all state schools. The next steps are...

- Collaboratively review the values and beliefs of the centre to support a shared understanding of prioritised practices and processes aligned to future opportunities and challenges.
- Develop a Curriculum, Assessment and Reporting Plan which documents a clear and consistent process to assist in implementing and monitoring the Australian Curriculum.
- Collaboratively revise with visiting schools, curriculum programs and delivery to provide a sequenced, integrated learning program for students before, during and after the camping experience.
- Develop professional learning plans for centre staff, with accompanying goals and timelines, to identify and address capability needs, career aspirations and staffing requirements.
- Develop a formalised data plan to provide a clear process for data collection and analysis.
- Strengthen partnerships, including those with First Nations people, to influence centre priorities and pursue future relevant partnerships to provide appropriate learning opportunities for students.
